This shortfall has been made up from financial reserves leaving reserves in the Bowling account at an all time low. Unfortunately, a Skittles evening which was planned for November to cover the anticipated shortfall had to be cancelled due to poor ticket sales.

End of season work on the green in October '24 consisted of two-way grading, scarifying, over seeding and application of a top dressing. Over the winter the green has been regularly cut to a height of 10mm and treated for disease and moss together with compost bio feeds. In February and March it will be hollow tined and scarified ahead of the new season.

Andy, our greenkeeper reports that other than some creeping weeds and moss (which is normal for this time of year and manageable) the green is in good condition.

A subscription entitles a bowler to use the Green throughout the week and as often as they wish. Bowlers should be aware that the Green can be busy on Tuesdays;

- From 10am till 2pm for bowling tuition
- In the evening from 6pm when the Green is reserved for Old Halesonian bowlers who have an exclusive group booking.

For visiting bowlers there is a nominal charge of **£2 per session** so that Subscribers can invite a guest to play. This charge should be added to your next subscription or passed to a committee member or Colin Gibbons.
